Riley has won numerous pageants in Missouri, taking home titles such as Miss Midland Empire, Miss Texas County, and Miss Maryville Outstanding Teen. This past summer, she competed in the prestigious Miss Missouri Pageant.

Riley was highly active in multiple activities at Clinton High School, including the POMS Dance Squad and DECA. She has also taught dance at By Grace Dance Studio in Clinton.
